The agreement - British *Columbia Tripartite First Nations Health Plan: Basis for a Framework Agreement on Health Governance* (the Basis Agreement), is a non-binding political agreement that sets the stage for the negotiation of a legal agreement on First Nations Health Governance.

The videoconference presentation on September 29th, 2010 offers First Nations Health Directors and their staff the opportunity to speak directly with senior officials about the *Basis Agreement*.
