The agreement - British Columbia Tripartite First Nations Health Plan: Basis for a Framework Agreement on Health Governance (the Basis Agreement), is a non-binding political agreement that sets the stage for the negotiation of a legal agreement on First Nations Health Governance.

The videoconference presentation on September 29<sup>th</sup>, 2010 offers First Nations Health Directors and their staff the opportunity to speak directly with senior officials about the *Basis Agreement*.
