




### Counts



- 2018 Point-in-Time Count
  - 32.7%
  - Proportional Access 33%
- COVID-19 Response Count (Pandora and Topaz, 182 people):
  - Of 66% male, 36% identify as Indigenous
  - Of 34% women, 42% identify as Indigenous

#### **HOMELESS COUNTS IN VANCOUVER**

(SLIDES ACCURATE AS OF MAY 12<sup>TH</sup>,2020)

- 2,223 total homeless people in Vancouver
- 6 1 4 live on the streets
- 609 live in shelters, safe houses, centers, hospitals, detox...etc
- Prisoners are not counted
